Make no mistake when you read Nancy Sanchez's email blast from September 10 and the proposal NYU presented on September 11. NYU is trying to make us pay for their bad decision to leave the League.

After saying they left to do better by their employees, NYU's proposal is only better for NYU and is wasting time that should be spent bargaining the contract we deserve.

This summer's League agreement provides for 3% wage increases each year plus fully funded benefits and other important rights including provisions important to our professional and technical employees, and economic and staffing language for Registered Nurses. On September 11, NYU

proposed the same wage increases as the League but—here's the catch—NYU said if they have to pay more than the League in Benefit Fund contributions we have to deduct those funds from our wage increases and benefits.

Don't be played by their proposal or their misleading emails. What they're proposing is equivalent to us paying for our own healthcare—something we've never done before and won't do now! This is just another attempt by NYU to get the benefit of the League rates without being in the League.
